The PFA Foundation and National PFA Alumni Association are pleased to announce that the first capital improvement project of the **FORGING THE FUTURE** Capital Campaign is in progress at Pine Forge Academy. The vision to upgrade and expand the academic and student life facilities on campus is becoming a reality. Phase One of the project is the total renovation of J.H. Wagner Hall (est. \$1.5 mil). Phase Two is the construction of the Paul R. Jones Student Center Multiplex which will house the cafeteria, auditorium and permanent Margaret Duncan Library.

Transformation of Wagner Hall will take place this summer. To date, we have secured \$500,000 of the amount needed for Phase One. Wagner Hall, named after the visionary leader and founder, Elder John H. Wagner and affectionately known as 'the Ad Building', has been the hub of learning at Pine Forge Academy since September 1955. Now, after over 50 years of service, we are embarking on a mission to fulfill the Strategic Plan for the Academy. Enhancements that will catapult Pine Forge Academy into the 21st Century so that it can continue to produce global leaders!

Mr. Don Kirkman, architect and Vice President of Maranatha Volunteers International, has been 'smitten' with Pine Forge Academy. He is fully committed to renovating and constructing the learning facilities that our students deserve. Maranatha will have a crew and craftsmen positioned to immediately begin the demolition and renovation of Wagner Hall the day after this year's graduation.
